Read the passage. Then answer the questions.

Tomas's First Sleepover

Scene I: Gabe and Eric are talking in front of Gabe's family's apartment building. Tomas walks by.

Gabe: Hi, Tomas. Are you coming to my sleepover this Saturday?

Tomas: (*mumbling*) Oh, uh . . . I forgot.

Gabe: How could you forget? It's a welcome-to-the-neighborhood sleepover for you!

Eric: All the guys are coming, and we're having pizza and ice cream.

Gabe: We're going to watch movies, too!

Tomas: Umm . . . I don't think I can come.

Eric: But you're the guest of honor, Tomas!

Gabe: Yeah. We just want to show you we're glad you moved here.

Tomas: Well—I'll think about it. (*He begins to move away from the others.*) I have to go home now . . . and . . . walk my dog. (*Tomas quickly walks down the street.*)

Gabe: Why wouldn't he come? I thought he knew the party was for him.

Eric: Maybe he didn't get your invitation. I'll stop by to see him on my way home.

Scene II: The kitchen in Tomas's family's apartment. Tomas is watching his older sister make a sandwich.

Tomas: Anna, how old were you when you went to your first sleepover?

Anna: I think it was in the third grade, so I was the same age as you.

Tomas: (*quietly*) Were you afraid to go?

Anna: (*hands him part of her sandwich*) You want to know the honest truth? I was terrified!

Tomas: Really?

Anna: Tomas, are you worried about the sleepover on Saturday?

Tomas: (*nodding*) I'm scared I might want to call home, and if I do that, I'm scared the guys will make fun of me. (*The doorbell rings. Anna opens the door, and Eric is standing outside.*)

Eric: Hi, Tomas. I just wanted to make sure you got the invitation to the sleepover. Gabe and I have prearranged a lot of fun things to do at the party!

Anna: I was just telling Tomas about my first sleepover. I called home at least three times!

Eric: That happened to me, too. (*He smiles and shakes his head.*) Actually, I had to call my mom to come get me. I didn't even stay the whole night! Boy, was I embarrassed, but it turned out to be no big deal.

Tomas: Really? The truth is, this would be my first sleepover.

Eric: Don't worry about it. The party will be just a bunch of guys having fun. It's Josh's and Aaron's first sleepover, too.

Anna: So, Tomas, do you want to borrow my sleeping bag?

Scene III: Gabe's family's apartment. Sleeping bags are scattered on the living room floor. The boys are watching a movie and eating popcorn.

Gabe: I'm glad you were able to come, Tomas.

Tomas: I'm glad, too. This is so much fun. (*lowers his voice*) Do you think I could call home?

Gabe: Of course! I bet your dad misses you. My dad always makes me call home when I'm sleeping over somewhere.

Tomas: (*walks into the kitchen and back again*) There's a line! Aaron's on the phone with his mother, and Josh is waiting to call home next!

Eric: (*hands Tomas a large bowl*) Have some more popcorn while you wait. It might be a while!
